

Intern Contributions to Cost of Ugandan Volunteers

While many students in the global 'north' have multiple opportunities to travel to other countries and gain work experience which strongly enriches their CV's and increases their earning power once they complete their studies, the same is not true for the vast majority of Ugandan students. Even when able to obtain a passport, visa restrictions make travel to countries such as the UK, US, France etc prohibitive and often impossible

In order to enable some equality of opportunity to Ugandan students who have not had any chance to pursue internships outside Uganda, the RLP requests its foreign interns to make a contribution towards the costs of our hosting a Ugandan volunteer. Thus for each month of the internship we request a contribution equivalent to the cost of hosting a Ugandan volunteer for one month, currently \$180/month.

1 month	\$180
2 month	\$360
3 month	\$540
4 month	\$720

*Internship applicants should note that interns are not covered by RLP's insurance policy and that on arrival they would be required to sign a waiver form to that effect. Interns are therefore encouraged to organize their own medical and accident cover insurance.

*When accepted, Interns are required to pay their fees in full (depending on the number of months) before they commence their placement at RLP.
